

Hi Yasmine,

As part of my annual request to the school boards for new school info, I also asked the CECCE for confirmation about the bus situation for next year for NDC. We are being told that those of us that are close to

the school will no longer get the bus...which might be ok if the speed humps were in and/or there was a regular crossing guard (not teachers). But it seems that neither of those is a sure thing right now.

I received a reply from the superintendant, in which he says that he met with Councillor Dudas and she confirmed that the City plans to install speed humps but that nothing was official since the budget wasn't approved. He also said she would be meeting soon with the parent council at NDC to discuss strategies to slow down traffic on Renaud Road. So the superintendant can't yet confirm the plans for next year because the speed humps haven't been approved yet. I thought the speed bumps were a sure thing and that we were just waiting on the exact timing for them? He also said that the school board does not hire crossing guards, which is why they are working with the City to hire some. Is there a way we can try to make this happen sooner? It seems there has been lots of back and forth on the crossing guard issue over the past couple of years.
